"THREE ASPECTS OF THE FIRST DEGREE THAT TOUCHED AND MOVED ME"

One of our ancient Sanskrit prayers goes thus:

"LEAD ME FROM UNTRUTH TO TRUTH, FROM DARKNESS TO LIGHT, FROM DEATH UNTO IMMORTALITY".

My expectations on the above lines had driven me to get initiated into FREEMASONRY!! How well was THIS realized!!

I give below those aspects which really touched and moved me in the first degree (initiation)

Getting admitted into Freemasonry; the process through which one gets initiated into, only after worthy recommendation, proposed by a Mason seconded by another and approved by one and all Masons of the Lodge! Blind-folded - in a state of darkness!! This indeed increased my curiosity to know what is the hidden mysteries and privileges of Freemasonry!!!

As an ardent admirer of SWAMY VIVEKANANDA, who himself a freemason, I cannot help but mention some of his sayings which go close to the rituals of this degree - as below:-

- ALL LOVE IS EXPANSION, ALL SELFISHNESS IS CONTRACTION. LOVE IS THEREFORE THE ONLY LAW OF LIFE. HE WHO LOVES LIVES, HE WHO IS SELFISH IS DYING. THEREFORE LOVE FOR LOVE'S SAKE, BECAUSE IT IS LAW OF LIFE, JUST AS YOU BREATHE TO LIVE.

- WE WANT TO LEAD MANKIND TO THE PLACE WHERE THERE IS NEITHER THE VEDAS, NOR THE BIBLE, NOR THE KORAN; YET THIS HAS TO BE DONE BY HARMONIZING THE VEDAS, THE BIBLE, AND THE KORAN.
- MANKIND OUGHT TO BE TAUGHT THAT RELIGIONS ARE BUT THE VARIED EXPRESSIONS OF THE RELIGION, WHICH IS ONENESS, SO THAT EACH MAY CHOOSE THE PATH THAT SUITS HIM BEST.
- THE SECRET OF RELIGION LIES NOT IN THEORIES BUT IN PRACTICE. TO BE GOOD AND DO GOOD - THAT IS THE WHOLE OF RELIGION
- o RELIGION IS THE MANIFESTATION OF THE DIVINITY ALREADY IN MAN.

These all, point out to a fact that there is a supreme power whatever name you give him, there is somebody up to take care of – to sooth our pains, relieve us from our sufferings in a most appropriate way one deserves! This is well understood in this degree.

NO GOD, NO PEACE; KNOW GOD KNOW PEACE!!!

This is the subtle message I could get during the rituals and I am really moved.

It was an interesting initiation ceremony and totally a different experience, where I was blind folded, relieved of all my material things wearing a peculiar attire, also a rope around my neck and lead by somebody inside the lodge.

Later I observed that this procedure of entrance is only to discover 'that light' under a solemn obligation!!!

A loving kindness for our fellow man, and a desire to do right because it is right. Masonry teaches that although all men are fallible and capable of much wrong, when they discover the goodness of heart, they have found the true essence of virtue. Masonry helps men see their potential for deep goodness and virtue - I mean Charity! Which made me to believe that it is not only more blessed to give than to receive, it's also more satisfying to a mason's heart!

I realize that, Freemasonry offers much to its members - the opportunity to grow, the chance to make a difference, to build a better world for our children. It offers the chance to be with and work with men who have the same values and ideals. Masonic philosophy which leads to a better understanding of the purpose of life and the need for care and concern for others.

Masons are dedicated to freedom and are champions of liberty. I have read that Masonic Lodges remained Sanctuaries where war passions were conciliated with brotherhood.
